Jay Winter Nightwolf is a Radio and Television Personality who hosts *The Nightwolf Show* on WPFW 89.3 FM. He is a Member of the Echota Cherokee Nation of Alabama and he is Washington Metropolitan Regional Coordinator of The Longest Walk. As a member of DCTV, he has led a partnership between DCTV and The Longest Walk.

On February 11th, Longest Walk participants embarked on a five month journey from San Francisco to Washington, D.C. They intend to arrive by July 11th and participate in the closing ceremony of the Alliance for Community Media Conference. The Longest Walk south route is being led by American Indian Movement co-founder Dennis J. Banks. It is a grassroots effort on a national level to bring attention to environmental concerns and sacred site issues, and to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the original longest walk in 1978. The Longest Walk and the ACM conference share a similar vision -- empowering the Voices of our diverse communities.
